

**NEWPORT TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 16, 2010**

A meeting of the Newport Township Authority was held on Thursday, September 16, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the Newport Township Municipal Building. In attendance were Authority members Peter Wanchisen, Joseph Deluca, Diane Hillan, and John Wilkes.

Mr. Wilkes called the meeting to order and those in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes of the Authority meeting held August 19, 2010 were read and approved. Mr. Deluca made a motion to accept the minutes, second by Mr. Wanchisen. Motion passed.

The Treasurer's Report was read and included the following:

A motion was made by Mrs. Hillan to accept this report, second by Mr. Deluca, motion passed.

Mr. Wilkes stated that the bids received on the 1 Engle Street Property were read on August 16, 2010 with the lowest bid being \$14,300. All bids will be sent to Pasonick & Associates for review to be presented at the Commissioners meeting in October.

64 East Main Street Property: Awaiting asbestos removal.

2-4-6 Third Street Property: We are waiting for the title on this property to move forward.

Bids for asbestos removal were received on the 64 E Main Street Property and 2-4-6 Third Street. The low bid was 1,700.00. Mr. Deluca made a motion for 1,700.00 payable to Datom Products Inc. for the removal of asbestos at these properties, second by Mr. Wanchisen. Motion passed.

Mr. Wanchisen presented the bids for the line painting in Ridgeview. Mayo line Striping submitted a bid for \$3,184.40 to paint a line from the Industrial Road to the top of Vista Drive. \$3,697.40 was the bid to included Overlook Drive. Mr. Deluca made a motion to paint the line from Industrial road to the top of Vista for \$3,184.40, second by Mrs. Hillan. Motion passed.

Mr. Wanchisen also thanked Newport Township and the DPW for sealing the cracks in the roads in Ridgeview.

With no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
