First Annual Firemen's/Little-League Bazaar held 22, 23 & 24 with a firemen's parade held on Saturday. The event was viewed as a success, and plans are being made for next year.

The firemen are requesting permission to move and store Engine #3 at a heated storage facility in Hunlock Creek.

The firemen are requesting permission to participate in the Shickshinny firemen's parade June 12. We are also asking for permission to attend the Slocum Township parade, Rice Twp. And Mountain Top parades. We are also asking for permission to attend the 6 County Firemen's Parade in McAdoo in the end of June.

We may not be able to attend these functions due to manpower and other unforeseen situations; however, we are requesting permission ahead of time. (Last year, even though we had permission, we did not attend any out of town parades)

We are asking permission to use Rescue #2 to return the "Moon-walk" we borrowed from Harleysville Fire Department. The date will be coordinated between Harleysville and our Department, and based on mutual convenience.

**Maintenance Issues:**

Engine #2 had to be taken to C&S Truck shop. It would not start. Both batteries and some switches had to be replaced. The bill was almost \$900.00 this constitutes almost 1/2 of our annual Maintenance budget.
