Crime Occurring in Newport Township Broken up by Sections

Month of December 2008

Glen Lyon

- December 10 - NTPD received a report of theft of a purse at Rock Street Apartments. Under further investigation.
- December 15- NTPD responded to a suspicious death on Newport Street. After further investigation by Police and coroner, it was ruled accidental pending a toxicology report.
- December 19- NTPD responded numerous reports of disabled vehicles throughout the township. Police were assisted by Newport Twp Fire and Bink's Towing
- December 23- NTPD served a warrant on E Union Street in Nanticoke for a male that was wanted to distributing a controlled substance and alcohol to a minor, causing injury.
- December 27 - NTPD responded a report of a domestic disturbance where a male threatened his live in girlfriend, stole her vehicle and checkbook and continued to make threats via telephone. He was later taken into custody by Police
- December 28- NTPD received a report of unauthorized use of an automobile. The vehicle was recovered and return to the owner. Owner wished not to pursue charges.

Sheatown

- December 2- An Edwarsville woman was arrested in the area of Prince Street for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol/Controlled Substance. She was also found with a small amount of marijuana in her possession.
- December 7- NTPD responded to an assault at 12 W Kirmar Ave. The suspect fled the area prior to officer arrival. Numerous offensive weapons were seized from the home including daggers, brass knuckles and a make shift bat with wrenches tapped to the end.
