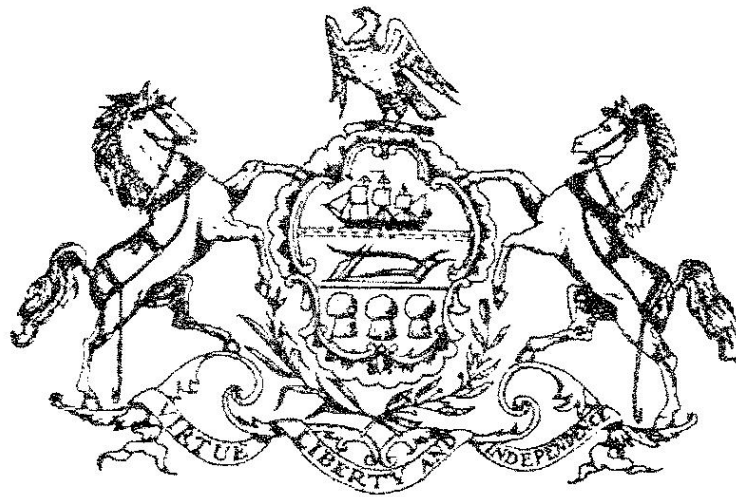

Glen Lyon

April 1 – A Glen Lyon man was arrested for DUI and other related charges when he was observed by Police operating an atv on a township roadway with a child aboard. He was also charged with fleeing police and resisting arrest.

April 2 – A Glen Lyon woman was arrested for DUI when she was observed operating her vehicle in an unsafe manner on West Kirmar Parkway.

April 15 – Police cited a Glen Lyon man after his dog bit a neighbor causing minor injury.

April 20 – Police charged a Glen Lyon woman and her daughter after they assaulted another female at the Rock Street bus stop during an argument.

April 22 – Police responded to a report of burglary on West Main where a new tenant had her door kicked in and a check stolen. The victim's bank account was frozen and the checks were voided. Further investigation.

April 24 – Police arrested a Glen Lyon woman for driving under the influence of drugs after she struck a parked car at the Rock Street Housing Project.

April 25 - Police cited 2 Glen Lyon juveniles for operating an ATV on Park Street in Glen Lyon.

Wanamie

April 11 – Police cited a Glen Lyon man and woman for curfew and underage drinking after they were stopped by Police on the West Kirmar Parkway.

April 24 – Police cited a Wanamie juvenile for operating his ATV on Old Newport Street.

Sheatown
