MONTH OF: August 2010

### GLEN LYON

Aug 8 - A Glen Lyon man was arrested on a local warrant in the rear of Market Street after being on the run for 3 years.

Aug 12 - Police arrested a Glen Lyon man for operating a vehicle while under the influence of heroin and driving without a license. Drug paraphernalia was observed in plain view inside the view. The vehicle was then impounded; a search warrant obtained which led to the discovery of approximately a bundle of heroin and other paraphernalia.

Aug 16 - Police investigated an alleged rape in the Glen Lyon section. After a detailed investigation was completed, it was learned that it was a false report was made by the victim.

Aug 20 - Police arrested a Glen Lyon man for domestic violence after he assaulted his live in girlfriend.

Aug 20 - Police arrested a Glen Lyon man on a warrant out of Wilkes-Bare Twp for retail theft and terroristic threats.

### WANAMIE

Aug 1 - Police assisted Nanticoke City Police in the apprehension of a wanted male in the Wanamie section of the township
