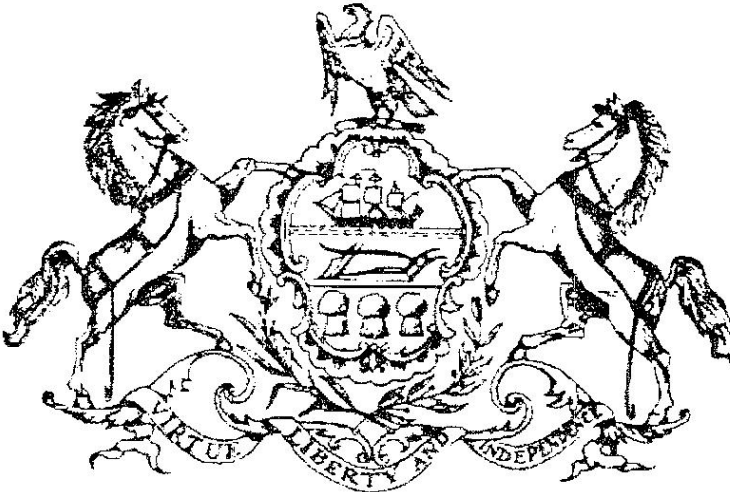

Glen Lyon

June 11 – Police responded to a fireworks complaint on Newport Street around 10:30 p.m. A man was cited for possessing and using illegal consumer fireworks (large mortar shells).

June 12 – Police responded to a report of a child bit by a pit bull dog on West Main Street. The owner was cited by both Township Police and State Dog Warden.

Wanamie

June 18 – Police conducted a Sobriety Check Point on West Kirmar Parkway with the PA State Police. A Glen Lyon man was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. He was almost three times the legal limit.

Sheatown

June 2 – Police cited a Wanamie man for operating his ATRV on Robert Street.

June 9 – A Sheatown man was committed to WBGH on a 302 after he made threats to harm himself.

June 21 – Police responded to a domestic disturbance on Simon Street between a juvenile and his mother's boyfriend, who was assaulted. After running the boyfriend's information, it was learned that he was wanted by Luzerne County Sheriff's Dept. and was taken into custody. The juvenile is also facing charges.

June 13 – A Nanticoke City juvenile was arrested for operating a dirt bike on the roadway and failed to stop when signaled by Police. He is receiving charges of fleeing a police officer and other traffic violations.

Alden

June 3 – Police responded to a report of an open burning in the Alden Area. A homeowner was cited under the township ordinance for burning roofing material.

June 10 – Police responded to a report of a female trespasser at a residence of Kirmar Terrace. The female was taken into custody for criminal trespass as she was warned by the property owner and Police not to return.

June 19 – Police responded to a young white male operating an ATV in a careless manner. Citations were filed on him for his actions.

June 24 – Police responded to a dog at large that almost bit someone. Police arrived on the scene, located the dog and the owner was cited as he was warned in the past about allowing his dog to roam the neighborhood.
