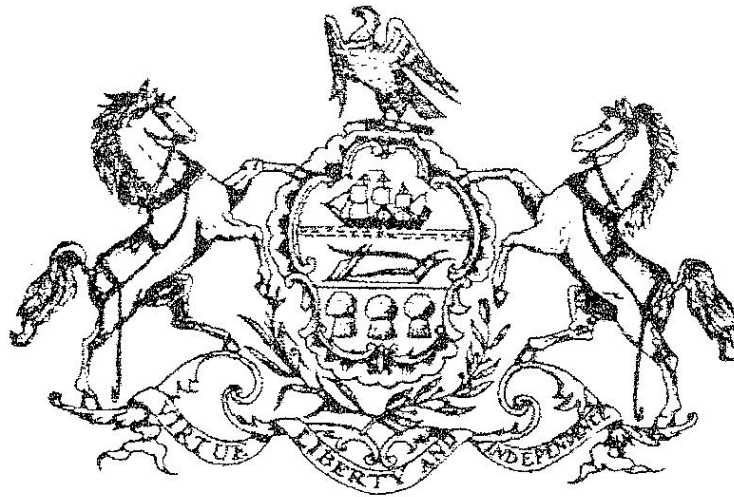

Glen Lyon

May 2 – A Glen Lyon man was arrested for domestic violence and criminal mischief after he struck his wife and slashed a vehicle's tires.

May 3 – Police arrested a Glen Lyon man who stole money from his mother's purse and also stole a flat screen TV from her home. The TV was recovered and he was charged. A co defendant was also charged in the theft of the TV.

May 9 – A West Nanticoke man was arrested for robbery and theft after stealing \$100.00 from the Variety Stop and punching the clerk in the face. Most of the money was recovered and he is facing charges.

May 12 – Police responded to a report of the theft of a Nintendo Wii gaming system from West Enterprise Street. Charges were filed on the suspect.

May 14 – A Glen Lyon man was arrested for domestic violence after he punched and threw his live in girlfriend into a wall.

May 19 – A Glen Lyon juvenile was cited for operating his ATV on Spring Street.

May 22 – A Glen Lyon man was arrested for disorderly conduct and resisting arrest after acting out and failing to stop yelling obscenities at officers. Police were forced to TASER the subject to take custody of him.

May 25 – A Glen Lyon man was arrested for violation a PFA and failing to follow an officer's order not to enter a residence. The man offered resistance and was TASERed and taken into custody.

Wanamie

May 21 – An Alden man was picked up on a criminal warrant out of this township for aggravated assault.

May 23 – A Wanamie man was arrested for DUI after he was involved in a motor vehicle accident on Old Newport Street.

Sheatown

May 19 – Police responded multiple calls of unlocked cars being broken into overnight and having items stolen.

May 21 – A Sheatown man was arrested for domestic violence after he punched his wife in the face, breaking her nose.

May 30 – A Glen Lyon male was arrested for aggravated assault after an officer attempted to break up an assault and was punched in the face by the offender. He was taken into custody and is facing charges.

Alden

May 6 – Police responded to a report of a female trespassing and refusing to leave a property. Upon arrival Police made contact with the woman who still refused to leave. The female's father became upset that the female has to leave and pushed the reporting officer. He was arrested and is facing charges.
